

Springfield News and Sun: Child left in car in 80-degree weather, woman arrested

SPRINGFIELD — A local woman was charged Tuesday, Aug. 18, after allegedly leaving an infant in a car while she shopped, according to a sheriff's report.

Tammy L. Day, 38, of 518 Wayne Drive, Fairborn, was arrested on a charge of endangering children, according to the report.

She allegedly left a baby in the back seat of her car while she shopped in a store in the 500 block of North Main Street, New Carlisle, around 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, according to the report.

Authorities estimated the temperature to be between 79 and 81 degrees during that time on Tuesday, according to the report.

Day was taken to Clark County Jail.
