In Ohio Calendar Year 2007, there were 106,538 new allegations of child abuse and neglect. Of these allegations, 34% (36,777) were neglect, 27% (28,621) were physical abuse, and 13%(13,477) were sexual abuse.

The Ohio Children's Trust Fund believes that one allegation of child abuse and neglect is one too many. We believe that all children deserve to be healthy, live in safe communities and raised in strong families.

In the spring of 1989, a Virginia grandmother began the blue ribbon campaign as a tribute to her grandson. The three-year old died at the hands of his mother's abusive boyfriend. Thousands of people nationwide wear the blue ribbon year round to create awareness of the need to prevent child abuse and neglect.

Wear your blue ribbon and take a stand against child abuse and neglect. Make a statement that, you too, share the belief that all children deserve to be healthy and raised in strong families and safe communities.
