

ODH's BCCP

Eligibility

ODH's BCCP provides screening services to women who:

- live in households with incomes less than 200 percent of the [poverty level](#)
- are uninsured or underinsured
- are 40 to 65 years of age for Pap tests and clinical breast exams; 50 to 65 years of age for mammograms

Health Coverage

ODH'S BCCP provides:

- breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services (no treatment)
- case management services to assist women receiving needed diagnostic tests and treatment services paid by other services
- a network of 600 screening providers statewide.

Enrollment Process

ODH'S BCCP screening and diagnostic services are:

- coordinated through 11 regional offices covering all 88 Ohio counties
