- d. The Prevention, Retention, Contingency (PRC) Program is an Ohio TANF funded program administered by CDJFSs. PRC "soft" services are services without cash value to the recipient (e.g., job training and education, after-school programs, etc.). Data on these services are collected through the PRC Web Reporting Tool (WRT).
