

Agencies In Noncompliance With Ohio Administrative Code Rule 5101:2-47-26.1

These agencies did not file a Title IV-E Cost Report for the period
January 1, 2001 - December 31, 2001

These agencies were requested to file a corrective action plan which will require that they file a Title IV-E Cost Report by September 30, 2002. If they implement the corrective action plan, then their rate will be effective for the rate year September 1, 2002 through August 31, 2003. However, failure to implement the corrective action plan may result in a cancellation of the Title IV-E rate. Please remember that if you have a child placed with an agency that has not filed a Title IV-E Cost Report you may be at risk of not receiving Title IV-E reimbursement for placement periods beginning September 1, 2002. It is advisable that you contact the agency to ascertain whether the agency intends to continue participation in the Title IV-E program. If the agency intends to continue participation, then they must file a Title IV-E Cost Report for the period January 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001.
