

BLOOD LEAD SCREENING REQUIREMENTS

Take this card with you to the doctor's office. If they have questions they should contact Provider Relations @ 1-800-686-6108.

- Mandatory screening- All 12- and 24-months-old Medicaid eligible children **must** have a blood lead screening test), as stated in the EPSDT rule 5101:3-14-03 paragraph (H).
- A Risk Assessment Questionnaire **is not** an acceptable substitute for the blood lead screening test.
- Every Medicaid eligible child between the ages of 36- and 72- months of age must have a blood lead screening test unless you have documentation that the child has been previously screened for lead poisoning.
- A blood test can be ordered or completed during any visit to a doctor's office.
