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## OVERVIEW

### Revisions to Methods for SFY 2009

#### Revisions to Methods After January 1, 2009

- The last report period for which results were calculated for Children with Special Health Care Needs performance measures is July – September 2007. Beginning in Spring 2008, ODJFS collaborated with the managed care plans (MCPs) to develop criteria to identify members who would benefit the most from care management services. This revamped approach will allow MCPs the flexibility to design care management programs that will direct resources to members demonstrating the greatest health care needs, and increase the potential to positively impact health outcomes, quality of life, and member satisfaction. The CSHCN performance measures were replaced by two MSHCN CM performance measures. The new care management performance measures for MSHCN will be in effect as of January 2009.

#### Data Sources

The sources of the data for calculating the measures is as follows:

- (1) MCP submitted encounter data
- (2) ODJFS' Recipient Master File
- (3) Case management data submitted and accepted in the Care Management System (CAMS).

#### Submission to the Care Management System (CAMS)

Appendix G, 3.b.iii.c.7 of the SFY 2009 Provider Agreement describes the required components of case management.

April – June 2009

## Care Management of High Risk Members

**Measure:** *The percent of high risk members who have had at least three consecutive months of enrollment in one MCP that are care managed.*

**Numerator:** Number of members in the denominator who are receiving care management services (excluding low and medium risk stratification levels as described in Appendix G) at any time from the most recent event for which they were identified as high risk and the end of the report period.

**Denominator:** Number of members statewide who: 1) were continuously enrolled in the MCP during the report period; 2) were identified through encounter data claims as being high risk by at least one of the following criteria:

- I. One hospital readmission within 90 days within the year prior to the report period.
- II. Three or more acute inpatient hospitalizations during the year prior to the report period.
- III. Two or more emergency department (ED) visits within 180 days within the year prior to the report period with a primary diagnosis of any of the following conditions: asthma, coronary artery disease (CAD), chronic obstructive pulmonary disorder (COPD), non-mild hypertension, congestive heart failure (CHF), severe mental disorder, substance abuse, or diabetes.
- IV. Two or more preventable ED visits (defined by NYU algorithm) within the year prior to the report period. This identification criteria will include only those ED visits that have primary diagnoses codes that the NYU algorithm assigns a probability of being primary care treatable and/or preventable/avoidable, excluding those diagnoses that have a probability of only being non-emergent.

**Exclusions:**

1. Any ED visit, as defined above, with the same member service date as a claim with CPT-4 Code of 99281-99285 in combination with a revenue center code of '456' (urgent care) or place of service code of '20' (urgent care), will be excluded from the numerator.
2. ED visits resulting in an inpatient stay (i.e., ED visits on the day prior to, or the same day, as the first day of an inpatient admission) will be excluded from the numerator. Inpatient stays are identified by Type of Bill codes 11x, 12x, 41x, 42x, and 84x on UB-92 claims.

**Numerator:** Sum of the numerators used to calculate the monthly care management rates during the report period.

**Denominator:** Sum of the denominators used to calculate the monthly care management rates during the report period.

### **Monthly Care Management Rate:**

**Numerator:** The number of members in care management (*including members assigned to low, medium, and high risk stratification levels*) during the reporting month who were in the denominator.

**Denominator:** The sum of all members statewide who: 1) had at least three months of consecutive enrollment in the MCP; and 3) were enrolled during the reporting month.
